

# Recommendations for a Successful Happy Bear Visit



Thank you for inviting the Happy Bear Program into your school or child care facility! Below is some information that will help ensure that you and your children experience the best presentation possible.

The Happy Bear Program will...

- Contact you to schedule Happy Bear's visit for a time that works for you
- Provide you with letters that inform parents of Happy Bear's visit and what to do should abuse occur with their child
- Be available to answer questions and address concerns from parents prior to the presentation
- Visit your school or child care facility and make the presentation
- Inform school counselors and child care providers about concerns about individual children that may arise during the presentation

The Happy Bear Program asks you to...

- Distribute the parent letter well at least a week prior to Happy Bear's visit
- Inform parents that they are welcome to attend the Happy Bear presentation
- Attend the presentation
- Be available after presentation to visit with Happy Bear presenters
- Report any suspicions of abuse or neglect to proper authorities
- Discard any old Happy Bear forms you may have on file and use the forms you find at [FSGCtopeka.com/HappyBear](http://FSGCtopeka.com/HappyBear)
- Complete the Happy Bear Program Survey for Educators
- If you received them, please work with your students to complete the FSGC Happy Bear Review Test and return them to Diane Wishall, FSGC, 325 S.W. Frazier Ave., Topeka, KS, 66606
