Applicants should have a demonstrated interest in working with youth as reflected by their practicum experiences. Although we do not require a specific type of practicum experience, those that are valued include experience in providing clinical services to youth with diagnosable conditions in an outpatient, inpatient, community mental health center or a school setting for youth with behavioral disturbances. Additionally, testing experience with youth, especially using some form of full-battery is highly desired. We rank applicants according to experience and demonstrated interests. Our most successful applicants have an understanding of the breadth and depth of diagnosable conditions as well as the extent of external environmental factors that influence youth and families' abilities to engage in treatment in a child community mental health setting.

To be an eligible applicant you must have a Masters degree in clinical psychology or equivalent and be licensable in the state of Kansas at the Masters level. It is a requirement that applicants be in good standing from an APA accredited doctoral program. Prospective applicants can review these requirements at <https://ksbsrb.ks.gov>. An applicant's completed APPI should include one psychological test report. We offer Zoom interviews, which usually are scheduled for Fridays in January. Every individual offered employment shall pass a background check and a drug screen.
